Westminster Shorter Catechism

Q.11: What are God's works of providence?

A: God's works of providence are his most holy, wise, and powerful preserving and governing all his creatures, and all their actions.

Q.12: What special act of providence did God exercise towards man, in the estate wherein he was created?

A: When God created man, he entered into a covenant of life with him, upon condition of perfect obedience; forbidding him to eat of the tree of knowledge of good and evil, upon the pain of death.
